THE GREAT GHAZIABAD HORSE SHOW 2012
NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN TENT PEGGING (NEC)
17 – 28 MARCH 2012

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Great Ghaziabad Horse Show & NEC Tent Pegging will be conducted according to the Rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) by Equiwings Sports & Events (P) Ltd in association with The Equestrian Association of U.P at the Ingraham Sports Stadium, Hapur Chungi, Near passport office, Ghaziabad (NCR) as per programme enclosed. The dates are as under:-

- (a) Horse Show & Championship : 17 – 27 March 2012
- (b) NEC Tent Pegging : 17 – 21 March 2012

2. **Classes:** Details of each class are given at **Appendix 'A'**.

3. **Entries :-**

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix 'B'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or entry form not accompanied with entry fee will not be considered. ALL ENTRIES FOR YOUNG RIDERS, JUNIOR RIDERS , SUB JUNIOR RIDERS AND CHILDREN RIDERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY BIRTH CERTIFICATES..

(b) **Entry Fee :-**

- (i) Team Events : Rs. 1000/- per team
- (ii) Individual Events : Rs. 500/- per exhibit

(c) **Closing Date for Entries:** Entries will close by **15 March 2012**. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES**. No entry will be accepted without an entry fee.

(d) **Post Entries:** Post entries will be accepted twenty four hours before the event.. Post entry fee will be :-

- (i) Team Events : Rs. 2,000/- per team
- (ii) Individual Events : Rs. 1000/- per exhibit

(e) **Description and Registration of Horses:** All entries must give the description, EFI Registration No., grading and name of the horse concerned. The name of the rider will be given for all mounted classes.

(f) **Payment:** All entries must be paid in *cash* or by cheque/DD in favour of **Equiwings Sports & Events (P) Ltd.**

4. Registration of Horses with EFI & HORSE PASSPORTS:-

- (a) As per EFI rulings, ALL horses participating in the Great Ghaziabad Horse Show 2012 in events which are recognized by the EFI in their technical guidelines ie, Dressage, Show jumping and Tent Pegging have to be registered with the EFI and must be accompanied by HORSE PASSPORTS issued by EFI. The EFI issues a Show Number which has to be used at all the shows conducted under the aegis of the Equiwings.
- (b) The registration fee is Rs. 150/-.
- (c) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered and have Horse Passports before entries for the Great Ghaziabad Horse Show 2012.

5. Withdrawal of Entry :-

- (a) Withdrawal: The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse/rider does not participate in the class.

6. Cancellation: The Organising Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded.

7. Eliminations: Eliminations will be held for all show jumping and tent pegging events. However, depending on the number of entries received, the Organising Committee may decide against this for any particular event. Eliminations will be held at the Ingraham Sports Stadium, Ghaziabad. (if required)

8. Reporting for Each Class: All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

9. Show Number: All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

10. Appeal: Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) should be deposited with the Organising Secretary – Equiwings, along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

11. Responsibility: The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

12. Cruelty to Animals: The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized. Refer to Article 13 to EFI Technical Guidelines 2006.

13. Whips/Spurs: As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

14. Grading of Horses: It will be the responsibility of the riders/clubs/units to ensure that their horses are entered in the correct grade as per the latest updated list. Entry of the horse in the wrong grade will entail elimination from that event and disqualification from the entire horse show. If it is the last event that the horse is taking part in, then a fine of Rs. 5,000/- will be deposited by concerned rider with the Organising Secretary, The Great Ghaziabad Horse Show before the horse leaves the camp, which will be forwarded to the Equiwings office. Failure to deposit fee may entail disqualification from next event whenever scheduled.

CAMPING

15. Camp: The Director, Ingraham Institute has arranged for stabling of horses for all participants at the Ingraham Sports Stadium, Ghaziabad for the duration of the Great Ghaziabad Horse Show & NEC Tent Pegging 2012. A minimum stabling charges would need to be submitted to Equiwings Camp office. Camp would be open on 13 March. All Teams must inform the Org. Secretary for participation and stabling maximum by 25 February. All information received thereafter would only be entertained after approval of OC.

16. Self Containment: All teams coming to participate in the Great Ghaziabad Horse Show & NEC Tent Pegging 2012 must be self-contained, ie, they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping, cooks and transport, etc. Any contingent requiring camping stables at the premises must contact the Office Superintendent by 10 March 2012. The same will be organized on payment.

17. Ration/Fodder: All participants are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/fodder to sustain their horses during their stay in Ghaziabad (U.P) or, they can ask for it with the Office Superintendent by cash payment.

- (a) Team : Will be conducted as per EFI Rules. The team will consist of 4 riders. (NEC)

- (c) Equiwings Confined Tent Pegging: Open to all school and College Club teams.: A team shall consist of 4 members. Total of 4 runs. 2 Runs with 6 cm pegs and 2 Runs with 4 cm peg. If there are not enough teams entered, the Committee reserves the right to make it an individual event. (All 8 classes)
- (d) Ghaziabad Horse Show (Regional) Tent Pegging: Open to all riders of India.(All 8 classes)
- (e) U.P. State : Open only to riders of the State of U.P.(U.P. State Championship) - (All 8 classes)

3. JUMPING EVENTS

- (a) Open Jumping Normal. Open to Grade I and II horses.
- (b) Grade III Jumping Normal. This event will be open to Grade III horses only. Maximum height 1.20 Mtrs and Maximum spread 1.30mtrs
- (c) Grade III Jumping Topscore. This event is open to Grade III horses only. It will be held under FEI rules
- (d) Novice Jumping Normal.
- (e) Novice Jumping Topscore. This event is open to Novice grade horses only. It will be conducted under FEI Rules.
- (f) Open Jumping Knockout. This event will be open to all horses. The event will be conducted under FEI rules. Competitors qualify under a separate elimination round judged under Table A or Table C rules.
- (g) Open Jumping Six Bar. This event will be open to all horses. The event will be conducted under FEI rules.
- (h) Preliminary Jumping Normal. Young Riders and Junior are both eligible to compete.
- (i) Preliminary Jumping Fault and Out.
- (j) Ride & Drive. Eliminations will be held over a course of 10 obstacles.
- (k) Senior, Young Rider and Junior Rescue Relay.
 - (i) This event will be held under FEI rules.
 - (iii) Maximum height 1.10m spread 1.20 m.
- (l) EAUP Young Rider Jumping As per FEI' Rules.
- (m) Young Rider Topscore As per EFI Rules.
- (n) Young Rider and Junior Jumping Knockout
- (o) EAUP Junior Jumping
- (p) Junior Jumping Topscore
- (q) EAUP Children Jumping Group I As per FEI.

4. SHOW CLASSES

- (a) Open Hacks- Open to all riders and horses. The judges will be judging the horses conformation, turn out of horse and rider. Simple movements will be asked to test the skill of the horse and rider and asses the harmony between the two.
- (b) Ladies Hacks- Open to lady riders.
- (c) Junior Hacks- Open to Junior riders. The judges will be giving points for the horses conformation, turn out of horse and rider. Simple movements will be asked to test the skill of the horse and the rider.
- (d) Equiwings Confined Hacks – Open to Riders of Equiwings Riding Club & members of EAUP.
- (e) Children Hacks Group I) The judges will be giving points for the horses
- (f) Children Hacks Group II) conformation, turn out of horse and the rider.
- (g) Children Hack Group III) Simple movements will be asked to test the skill of the horse and rider.
- (h) Confined Hacks - Confined hacks opens to EAUP members and its horses only.
- (i) U.P. State Open Hacks – for Riders of U.P. State Only
- (ii) U.P. State Ladies Hacks – for female riders of State of U.P
- (iii) U.P. State Children Hacks Gp.1,2 & 3 separately

NOTES:

1. Age Categories and Eligibility of Riders as per EFI/FEI Rules:

- (a) Young Rider (16 to 21 years).
- (b) Junior Rider (14 to 18 years).
- (c) Children Group I (12 to 14 years)
- (d) Children Group II (10 to 12 years)
- (e) Children Group III (09 years & below)

2. You are requested to fill in the entry form correctly as per the blocks in the age groups as stated. This has been done in view of giving more children a chance to perform well. BIRTH CERTIFICATE MUST BE ATTACHED.

3. Eligibility of Riders:

- (a) A Young Rider/Junior Rider/Children I – 12 years and above, can participate in an Regional Senior Event in Dressage and Jumping in the same show on an appropriately graded horse without effecting their JNEC status.
- (b) In Tent Pegging a Young Rider/Junior rider 16 years and above, can participate in an Regional Senior Event in the same show but not on the same horse as entered in their respective category without affecting their JNEC status.
- (c) Since there is an overlap of age in all categories, the rider has a choice to participate in a higher category in the Regional Show. However, once the rider decides to participate in a particular category he/she cannot be downgraded and will continue to remain in the

category from that day onwards. Such riders can further upgrade themselves in subsequent JNEC's only once they are in the age bracket of the category to which they upgraded themselves.

4. Eligibility of Horses for Jumping:

- (a). Preliminary/Novice/Grade III horses only can participate in National Young rider, junior and children show jumping events.
- (b) Grade I and Grade II horses cannot participate in any of the young rider/junior/children-I/children-II show jumping/eventing competitions.

5. Reporting for each Class:

- (a) All riders must report to the collecting ring steward half an hour before the event for Hacks/Gymkhana races.
- (b) The first three riders in dressage and first five riders in jumping must report to the arena stewards atleast 15 minutes before the scheduled start that event.
- (c) The arena steward has full authority to take appropriate action as per existing rules if competitors are late.

6. For Group III Children events, the Riders will be permitted to be held by a Syce. However, they must be able to ride alone for the hacks, dressage and jumping. For Beginner (Novice) Horse Riding Competitions/Test, the riders would be permitted help of their syce while mounting & dismounting.

7. Gymkhana events and hacks are not counted for Best Junior or Child Rider Group I, Group II and Group III.

8. SPECTATORS ARE REQUESTED NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE JUDGES. THE ARENA STEWARD HAS THE RIGHT TO ELIMINATE ANY PARTICIPANT WHO HAS OUTSIDE HELP. ONCE THE EVENT HAS COMMENCED ALL SPECTATORS AND HELPERS ARE REQUESTED TO CLEAR THE ARENA. IN THE GROUP III RACES CHILDREN ARE PERMITTED A SYCE TO HOLD THE HORSE. IN THE GROUP I & GROUP II RACES CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED ANY ASSISTANCE WHATSOEVER. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL. PARENTS MUST NOT ENTER THE ARENA OR DISPUTE THE JUDGES DECISION.

9. Competitors are required to be correctly dressed for all the events. Civilians should wear a Blazer and Tie. Competitors improperly dressed can be disqualified. Hard hats must be worn. In gymkhana events a white shirt and tie are permitted

10. Competitors are responsible for entering correct grades or categories. The EFI has made a new list of grade for Dressage and Show Jumping horses. The Organising Committee will NOT be held responsible for incorrect entries.

11. ANY DOUBTS/QUERIES/CLARIFICATION MAY BE SOUGHT WELL BEFORE THE EVENT.
